Thinking of taking the **OLD SAT** or the ACT? As a reminder, if you are taking the Old SAT, the last administration of the exam will be in January, 2016. If

you are planning to take any tests this spring, be sure to register with the College Board (www.collegeboard.org) or the ACT (www.act.org).

If you receive testing accommodations, and you will be taking either the SAT Reasoning or Subject tests, check with your counselor to ensure that an application has been submitted to the College Board. Please allow up to six weeks prior to the exam for the processing of your request.
