Dear Parents/Guardians,

I am pleased to provide you with the January 2019 schedule for midterm assessments and Regents exams. As I highlighted in my August mailing, we will continue a four-day midterm week. By providing this dedicated examination time, students will be able to focus solely on their assessments without the additional pressure of attending their regular classes. Additionally, teachers will have an opportunity to assess student progress at the midpoint of the school year.

**Testing week exams have been scheduled from January 22<sup>nd</sup> - 25<sup>th</sup>.** Please review the attached schedule with your child and keep it in a visible place for reference. This general schedule has also been posted on the High School and Middle School website main pages. The last day of regular classes, prior to testing, will be Friday, January 18<sup>th</sup>. Please note that we are embedding high school level English exams into midterm week this year. They have been spread out over the four day testing schedule. We have also dedicated Thursday, January 17<sup>th</sup> and Friday, January 18<sup>th</sup> for universal in-class review days.

Teachers will inform students of the exact times and locations of their respective exams. Comprehensive templates of the schedule will also be made available on the District websites in early January. In addition, we will post the midterm assessment in central locations within the Secondary School no later than the afternoon of Friday, January 11<sup>th</sup>.

During the testing days, the cafeteria will be open from 7:30 AM – 12:00 noon. A light menu/snacks will be available for students.

In order to protect the integrity of the examinations, we ask that students *only* report to school for their scheduled assessments and for previously arranged teacher-led review sessions. Should students arrive early to school or complete an examination prior to the end of the scheduled testing period, they will be directed to the Cafeteria (1/22-1/25) or the High School Media Center (1/23-1/25). Students will NOT be allowed to congregate in the hallways.

The use of any electronic device (e.g. cell phones, tablets, smartwatches, etc.) other than those approved by department supervisors for testing situations (e.g. calculators, devices for students with physical disabilities) may not be used or handled at any time during an exam. Students in violation of this directive may be removed from the exam and have their score for that test/Regents exam nullified.

School attendance, always a high priority at Manhasset schools, becomes even more important during the midterm review period. Please make every effort to ensure your child's attendance prior to midterm week. Be advised that absences from exams during testing week will only be excused with a physician's note.
