



# Manhasset Public Schools

Dear Parents:

**We are pleased to announce that this year's Junior Prom will be held at the Bridgeview Yacht Club on Saturday, March 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2019.** The evening begins with our annual *Promenade* at 6:00 P.M., then on to the Bridgeview Yacht Club for a memorable celebration! We will return to the Secondary School campus @ 12:00 A.M.

Transportation onto the Campus: **A parent may accompany up to three students to the Promenade.** Only MHS parents are permitted to transport students to and from the drop off and pick up point (the rear parking lot by the gymnasium entrance). At the end of the evening, at approximately 12:00 A.M., only parents of the attendees or designated MHS parents may pick up the students.

The Class of 2020 invites all parents to attend *The Promenade*, an hour-long reception held prior to your child's departure to the Bridgeview Yacht Club. We ask you to arrive at the high school gymnasium entrance between 6:00 and 6:15 P.M. Upon arrival, each attendee will receive a boarding pass for transportation to the Bridgeview Yacht Club via a chartered bus. **Boarding passes will be issued until 6:30 PM. It is expected that the parents remain until 6:45 P.M.** The gathering will offer light refreshments, provide you with an opportunity to meet your child's friends and parents, as well as take photographs.

At approximately 6:45 P.M., all juniors and their guests will board luxury coach buses that will take them to the reception at the Bridgeview Yacht Club. Students will not be permitted to bring any snacks, refreshments, bottles, etc. onto the buses.

Juniors do not have to bring a guest to the prom! All juniors are encouraged to attend the prom and enjoy the camaraderie and elegance that this evening offers to all the members of the Class of 2020 without feeling the obligation to bring a guest.

**MHS Students with MHS Guests:** Juniors who invite a MHS sophomore, junior or senior to the Junior Prom **must complete Form A and hand it in at the time of ticket purchase.** Freshmen are not permitted to be a guest.

**MHS Students with A Non-MHS Guest:** MHS juniors may invite a guest in grades 10, 11, or 12, who attend a high school other than MHS. Juniors may also invite a college freshman who graduated from Manhasset High School in 2018. In this case, **both Form A and Form B must be completed and submitted at the time of ticket purchase. A copy of the guest's school ID is also required.**

Our primary responsibility and concern for each attendee at this gala event is safety. Therefore, any student behavior or condition that is viewed as inappropriate or not in the best interest of student health or safety will receive immediate review by an administrator.

The Junior Prom is, of course, a Manhasset High School sponsored event. All rules and regulations from the district code of conduct are in effect for the entire evening. Any violation of the district code will result in immediate disciplinary action both at the prom site and upon return to school. For example, any student and guest who attends this event under the influence of alcohol or any other drug, or who possesses or

imbibes alcohol or any other drug during this event will be escorted from the event area to an office. As per Board of Education Policy 5445, any student suspected of consuming alcohol will be asked to use a breathalyzer. After a review of the matter, an administrator will then call the parent of the student and/or guest in violation of the code of conduct. However, the parents of both the student and guest will be requested to immediately pick up his or her child from the prom if the student or guest consumed alcohol. A grade level assembly will occur on Friday, March 1<sup>st</sup> to outline this policy, as well as provide details of the evening. **The consequences for possession of and/or under the influence of alcohol or drugs at the dance are:**

1. **Three day out of school suspension, March 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, and 6<sup>th</sup>, 2019**
2. **Three week social suspension, March 4<sup>th</sup> – March 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2019**
3. **A 10<sup>th</sup> grade student will be prohibited from attending the 2020 Junior Prom and may not attend the 2019 Senior Prom as a guest.**
4. **An attend 11<sup>th</sup> grade student will be prohibited from attending the 2020 Senior Prom and may not attend the 2019 Senior Prom as a guest.**
5. **A 12<sup>th</sup> grade student will be prohibited from attending the 2019 Senior Prom.**

**Tickets for the Junior Prom will be on sale in the main hallway on Thursday, February 14<sup>th</sup> and Friday, February 15<sup>th</sup> during periods 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 (from 10:00 A.M. until 1:30 P.M.). Students needing financial assistance should notify their guidance counselor before Friday, February 8<sup>th</sup>, 2019.**

**It is the Manhasset junior's responsibility to inform his or her guest of the administrative actions and consequences for the above violations of the district code of conduct.**

- The cost of each ticket for this special evening of camaraderie is \$145.00.

- No tickets will be sold the evening of the event.
- **All attendees must present a completed and signed Form A.**
- **Juniors who choose to bring a guest from another high school must provide a completed and signed Form A and Form B.**
