### CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

**Bookworms, grades 1 - class size limit 15 - Mrs. Olwy, Library:** Enjoy books written and illustrated by award winning author-illustrators such as Mo Willems, Brian Pinkney, Lois Ehlert, Eric Carle and more. Learn about and practice their different styles of illustration - collage, scratch art, pulp painting, charcoal and more. Join Mrs. Olwy in the library for this fun "hands-on" class.

**Magic, grades 4,5 – class size limit 10 – Mr. Rockis, Library:** Learning magic takes focus and discipline. It also builds confidence. It will be a supportive, environment where students won't be intimidated with taking risks. They will learn about public speaking, and how to "talk up the trick" using vocabulary that will enhance the illusion, and amaze their audience. The children will learn how to become resilient, by correctly responding when a trick may go wrong. The students will learn how to persevere and positively respond to trial and error. This will help them to become self-assured and assertive.

**Spanish for Beginners I, grades 1,2 - class size limit 12 - Mrs. DeCicco, Room K01:** This class teaches Spanish through music, theater, arts and crafts, counting activities, games and conversation. Students will learn how to say hello, name their body parts, order food, and identify colors and common objects through fun, engaging activities.

**"Readers' Theater", grades 2 – class size limit 15 – Mrs. Olwy, Library:** Join Mrs. Olwy in the library as we combine children's literature with theater. We will use color-coded, age appropriate scripts created from children's literature. After practicing with their groups, children will sit together and perform their story for the other children. There are no sets, costumes, props, or need to memorize lines. We will perform folk tales, short biographies and funny poems. A side benefit of this activity is that it allows a student to improve comprehension and fluency skills in a fun and stress-free setting. We also work on reading with expression and other elements of performance.

**Chess, grades 2,3 – class size limit 20 – Mrs. Blank, Room 209:** Spend your Thursday morning learning beginner strategies and basic moves with Mrs. Blank.

**Legos, grades 2,3 - class size limit 20 - Mr. Putnam, Room 217:** Students will create Legos using problem solving and building skills.

**“Forensic Science: Scientists are like detectives!” grades 3, 4, 5 - class size limit 12 - Mrs. Viscovich, Science Lab, Room 231:** Come learn all about how your favorite detectives use science to figure out unsolvable thefts, arsons, mysteries, and more. Students will love collecting dental impressions, studying their classmates’ fingerprints, looking at tool marks left at the scene of the crime, analyzing mysterious powders, and discovering the various types of counterfeit checks.

**Sports/Games, grades 3, 4, 5, 6 – class size limit 20 - Coach Muller and Coach Williams, The Gym:**  
This class will run from 8-8:40 am.

**Kindness Club, grades 4,5,6 – class size limit 15 - Mrs. Levine, Room 229:** Do projects to benefit those right here on LI. Past projects include Project Linus Blankets: these no-sew blankets bring comfort to those experiencing illness or loss. Coups for Troops: Cut coupons to send to military families overseas. Around the holidays, we will make projects for residents of an assisted living facility. Decorate book plates for donated books given to Ronald McDonald House. Learn about ReesSpecht Life, Miles of Smiles and other wonderful ways you can pay it forward. Together, we will make a difference in the lives of others.

**S.T.E.M., grades 4,5,6- class size limit 15 – Ms. Kinsel, Room 223:** Ready for innovative, engaging, and fun STEM challenges? In this class, students will learn skills essential for the future as they design, experiment, and model projects and challenges relating to science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM). Students will engage in questioning, problem solving, collaboration, and hands-on activities while they address real-life issues. Install a lifelong love of science NOW!
