### **Book Fair**

March. Volunteers assist with inventory, finances, restocking and decorating for the book fair. Work begins in the Fall. Book fair runs for a week in March.

## **Box Tops for Education**

Periodic. Volunteers organize the collection and redemption of Box Top labels. Organize school contest January- March. Minimal time commitment.

### **Bulletin Boards**

Monthly. Volunteers work with the art teachers to update bulletin boards.

### **MP Book Week**

November. Volunteers organize a week of activities for students to celebrate books. Volunteers work closely with the librarian.

## **Directory**

September/October. Volunteers prepare, proof and distribute the school directory. Compile and update information.

### **Extended Extras**

Volunteers coordinate with teachers to offer classes before and after school. Fall Session(October-February), Spring Session(March-May).

Grade Level Chairs (Ongoing) act as a liaison between the SCA leadership and the Room Representatives. Responsible for reporting issues in their grades and contacting room representatives via email regarding school and SCA news. Facilitates communication about the budget through room representatives. Required to attend monthly GLC meetings and to serve as a volunteer at the SCA Fair. Expected to attend SCA meetings and at least one Board of Education meeting.

## **Guess Who's Coming to Read**

Volunteers coordinate a reading event for grades K-4. Community members visit the classrooms to read a story and share their love of reading. Event is one morning in January.

## Halloween Party (5th and 6th grade)

Party takes place the Friday night before Halloween. Planning from September-October. Many volunteers needed to run subcommittees for both grades. Fifth grade chairs needed and will work directly with 6th grade chairs and then continue as chairs the following year.

## **Holiday Gift Giving Program/Project Share**

November/ December. Volunteers work with the school social workers to organize and collect gifts during the holiday season. Gifts are donated to families in need in our community. Works in conjunction with Project Share. A district wide effort to help fill the basic needs of economically challenged families in the community. Strictly confidential.

# **Family Theatre**

Volunteers coordinate two theatre performances a year, manage ticket sales, and advertising. Performances are held on a Saturday afternoon.

## **Health and Wellness**

Volunteers coordinate Health and Wellness Week at Munsey Park.

## Membership

September/January. Volunteers distribute SCA membership forms and collect dues at Open House.

## Go Green Week/Earth Day Chair

Go Green Week/Earth Day Chair is responsible for organizing activities and programming related to go green week/Earth Day in April. This person is not responsible for maintaining the gardens.

## **Planet Manhasset/Community Gardens Chair**

This person will be the main point person for all three gardens located in the district; Munsey Park, Shelter Rock, and the High School. The chairperson will coordinate with school administrators, teachers, HS Green Club, Scout Troops and interested members of the community to maintain the edible organic garden at the high school as well as the monarch butterfly way stations at MP and SR. This chairperson will also be responsible for organizing fundraising opportunities for Planet Manhasset throughout the school year.

## **Saturday Series**

Volunteers coordinate Saturday Series classes and registration. Also involved in running Saturday Series on Saturday mornings.

September/October

October. Volunteers partner with CASA to plan a week of events to promote awareness about healthy living.

## Safety
