Afternoon classes begin at 3:30PM and end at 4:20PM. Each subject is \$140 (unless other fees are noted) and meet 8 times. You may sign up for as many classes as you like. All classes have a size limit as noted. **Registrations will be accepted on a first come, first served basis**. Make-up classes will be scheduled in the event the teacher has a conflict. There will be no make-ups for delayed openings or school closings due to inclement weather. ### **CLASS DESCRIPTIONS**

Advanced Magic – Grades 4-6 Thursdays with Mr. Rockis, Library (class size limit 12) Is your child interested in Magic? Participants in this class will learn how to do <u>advanced</u> table magic tricks using playing cards, coins and other "house-hold items". This class will help children with following multi-step directions, using deductive reasoning, and enhancing their receptive, expressive and pragmatic language skills. This class is limited to 12 students, since the magic being taught requires close up participation. Beginner Magic is NOT a Pre-requisite. This class was previously offered Spring 2017. All materials needed will be provided.

**Beginners Spanish – Grades 1-2 Wednesdays with Mrs. DeCicco (Class size limit 14)** The class will introduce children to basic Spanish words and vocabulary in a fun and easy way, including videos, games, songs and stories.

**Bookworms - Grades 1 & 2 Thursdays with Mrs. Olwy, Library:** Enjoy books written and illustrated by award winning author-illustrators such as Mo Willems, Brian Pinkney, Lois Ehlert, Eric Carle and more. Learn about and practice their different styles of illustration - collage, scratch art, pulp painting, charcoal and more. Join Mrs. Olwy in the library for this fun "hands-on" class.

Chess - Grades 4 - 6 Mondays and Grades 2 - 3 Tuesdays with Mrs. Blank, Room 209 (class size limit 20): Spend your mornings learning chess strategies and strategic moves with Mrs. Blank.

Creative Crafts - Grades 1 - 2 Tuesdays and Grades 3 - 5 Wednesdays with Mrs. Mora, Room 121 (class size limit 24): This class is filled with innovative craft-making experiences that are sure to keep big minds engaged and fulfilled! The course will allow students to use their own creative flair to produce one-of-a-kind, personalized works of art. <u>\$15 supplies fee</u>. **Debate Club - Grades 4-6 Thursday afternoons with Mrs. Blank, Room 209 (class size limit 16)** Introduction to Debate Club will give students a fun way to develop their communication skills. Students will take part in different activities to help with their critical thinking, art of persuasion and confident communication. <u>This class runs from 3:30 - 4:20</u>

**Exercise/Running Club - Grades 4 - 6 Thursday afternoons with Mrs. Mora & Ms. Vincent (class size limit 24):** Want to improve your speed & agility? In this class we will work on proper running form and performance while building stamina and confidence. We will be incorporating indoor exercises as well as outdoor running this term. Please be sure to bring proper running sneakers and a water bottle. Meet in room 121. <u>This class runs from 3:30 - 4:20</u>

**Gifts of the heART Crafting - Grades 3-4 Wednesday Afternoons and Grades 5-6 Fridays with Mrs. Levine, Room 229 (class size limit 10):** Come to create, design and give gifts of the heART. Completed projects can be shared with loved ones for Mother's Day, Father's day, birthday or just to say I was thinking of you! Anticipated projects: stencil and paint a wood sign, make a set of magnets, decorate a pencil case/makeup pouch, a trinket dish, ceramic tile project and make gift tags. Each gift will be wrapped with love. <u>Materials fee \$15</u>

Mornings on the Mat - Grade K-6 Tuesdays with Coach Muller and Mrs. Olwy, Library (class size limit 25): *Mornings on the mat* will offer a blend of mindfulness and yoga! Open to students in grades K-6, students will create projects, learn how to calm their minds, and relax and strengthen their bodies through yoga! Mats will be provided.

Legos - Grades 2-4 Thursdays with Mr. Putnam, Room 219 (class size limit 20): Students will build and create with Legos. Each week students will accomplish a specific task with their Legos based on various themes.

**Keyboarding Club - Grades K-2 Mondays with Mrs. Costello, Computer Lab (class size limit 20):** Enhance your typing skills with the correct form by using our typing club program as well as other fun typing games in the lab! The more practice, the faster you'll get!

**Kindness Club - Grades 4 - 6 Wednesdays with Mrs. Levine, Room 229 (class size limit 12):** Our club focus is to learn small ways to pay it forward. Projects may include coupon cutting to benefit a military family, collecting and wrapping hotel toiletries for families in need, collecting gently used books for Book Fairies and taking charge of the school plastic recycle program. We often find ways to promote random acts of kindness. We have a baking date at the Ronald McDonald House in New Hyde Park in March, details will be provided at our first meeting. Together, we will make a difference in the lives of others.

**Kitchen Science – Grade K-2 Wednesdays with Mrs. Viscovich, Science Room** (class size limit 14): Did you know that your kitchen is actually a science lab where tons of cool science experiments happen! Cook and Mix your way through Kitchen Science and learn lots of cool stuff along the way! Students will use common household items to see physical and chemical changes. <u>Materials fee \$15</u>

OzoBOT - Grades 1-2 Wednesdays with Ms. Costello in the Computer Lab (class size limit 12) Students will learn how to operate Ozobot, how Ozobot senses its environment and moves in it, and how to tell Ozobot what to do using Color Codes. Students will learn how to create these color codes and code the Ozobot to follow it.

**OzoBot - Grades 3-4 Thursdays with Ms. Costello in the Computer Lab (class size limit 12)** Students will learn how to operate Ozobot, how Ozobot senses its environment and moves in it, and how to code Ozobot what to do using Color Codes. Students will be introduced to OzoBlockly. Students will create color codes for the bot to follow. Students will also open a premade program, edit it, then load it to their bot, all while learning the features of the code editor.

**OzoBot - Grades 5-6 Tuesdays with Ms. Costello in the Computer Lab (class size limit 12)** Students will learn how to operate Ozobot, how Ozobot senses its environment and moves in it, and how to tell Ozobot what to do using Color Codes and be introduces to OzoBlockly. Students will create color codes for the bot to follow. Students will also open a premade program, edit it, then load it to their bot, all while learning the features of the code editor. Students will be introduced to additional challenges with the bots.

Spanish for Incoming Middle School Students – Grade 6 Tuesday and/or Thursdays with Ms. Marquez in the Library Tower Room (class size limit 8) This class will consist of Spanish teaching resources for a fun, original and interactive way of teaching Spanish. *Each day has a \$140 per term charge.* 

Sports/Games - Grades 3-6 Thursdays with Coach Muller and Coach Williams, Gym (class size limit 30): This class will run from 8 - 8:40 AM.

Storytime Craft - Grade K Thursdays with Mrs. Meoli Room 119 (Class size limit 12): Children will be encouraged to practice their listening skills while being read a fun, adventurous story and follow-up with a story-related craft. Story retell, sequencing and following directions are emphasized. Hope you can join us!

Study Skills - Grades K - 6 Tuesday afternoons with Mrs. Blank & Mr. Putnam, Room 209 (class size limit 20): Students will learn organizational strategies while completing daily and long term classroom/homework assignments. Students will be guided as they prepare and study for upcoming assessments. <u>This class runs from 3:30</u> - 4:20 The Magical World of Moana - Grades 3 & 4 Tuesday afternoons with Ms. Gliksman in the Science Lab (class size limit 15): Come create amazing colorful art projects as we explore Hawaiian culture. Children will create bark paintings, called "Kapa", using different traditional techniques and painting styles. Children will also hand build colorful Pacific Totem sculptures while exploring different clay building techniques. Come sing the classic songs from Moana and explore Hawaiian culture. <u>This class runs</u> from 3:30 - 4:20

Theatre Arts Class - Grades 4-6 Thursdays with Mrs. O'Donnell in the All Purpose Room (class size limit 15): Are you creative? Do you like to act? Each week explore your creativity through improvisation, creative movement, and learn the basics of drama through ensemble. Please be sure to dress comfortably and wear sneakers for the activities.

**Wizarding World of Harry Potter - Grades 4-6 Tuesdays with Mr. Rockis in the Library (class size limit 12)** Is your child a fan of Harry Potter? Here your child will be immersed in all things Hogwarts. There will be Harry Potter inspired crafts, trivia, magic and games. Classes will meet on Platform 9 ¾ in the library.
