Afternoon classes begin at 3:30PM and end at 4:20PM. Each subject is \$140 and meets 8 times. You may sign up for as many classes as you like. All classes have a size limit as noted. **Registrations will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis.** Make-up classes will be scheduled in the event the teacher has a conflict. CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Storytime Yoga - Grade K, Tuesdays with Mrs. Olwy, Library (class size limit 12):

Children will be introduced to different breathing and visualization techniques. We will warm up with gentle stretches. Each week children will practice simple yoga poses that are woven into stories and games. We will practice partner poses and end each class with a quiet guided relaxation. No special equipment needed. Kids should wear comfortable clothes. We will take our shoes off and work on the library carpet.

Bookworms - Grades 1 & 2, Thursdays with Mrs. Olwy, Library: Enjoy books written and illustrated by award winning author-illustrators such as Mo Willems, Brian Pinkney, Lois Ehlert, Eric Carle and more. Learn about and practice their different styles of illustration - collage, scratch art, pulp painting, charcoal and more. Join Mrs. Olwy in the library for this fun "hands-on" class.

S.T.E.M. - Grade K, Tuesdays with Mrs. Viscovich, Room 223 (class size limit 15):

Ready for innovative, engaging, and fun STEM challenges? In this class, students will learn skills essential for the future as they design, experiment, and engage in questioning, problem solving, collaboration, and hands-on activities while they address real-life issues. Install a lifelong love of science NOW!

S.T.E.M. - Grades 3 & 4, Thursdays with Mrs. Kinsel, Room 216 (class size limit

15): Ready for innovative, engaging, and fun STEM challenges? In this class, students will learn skills essential for the future as they design, experiment, and engage in questioning, problem solving, collaboration, and hands-on activities while they address real-life issues. Install a lifelong love of science NOW!

Keyboarding Club - Grades K, 1 & 2, Mondays with Mrs. Costello, Computer Lab (class size limit 20): Enhance your typing skills with the correct form by using our typing club program as well as other fun typing games in the lab! The more practice, the faster you'll get!

Coding - Grades 3 & 4, Tuesdays with Mrs. Costello, Computer Lab (class size limit 15): Learn or practice the basic of coding using various programs like code.org, KIDOYO and Scratch.

Chess - Grades 4 - 6, Mondays and Grades 2 - 3, Wednesdays with Mrs. Blank, Room 209 (class size limit 20): Spend your mornings learning chess strategies and strategic moves with Mrs. Blank.

Legos - Grades 2 & 3, Thursdays with Mr. Putnam, Room 219 (class size limit 20): Students will build and create with Legos. Each week students will accomplish a specific task with their Legos based on various themes.

Sports/Games - Grades 3 & 4 Tuesdays and Grades 5 & 6 Thursdays with Coach Muller and Coach Williams, Gym (class size limit 24): This class will run from 8 - 8:40 AM.

Exercise/Running Club - Grades 4 - 6, Thursdays with Mrs. Mora & Ms. Vincent (class size limit 24): Want to improve your speed & agility? In this class we will work on proper running form and performance while building stamina and confidence. We will be incorporating indoor exercises as well as outdoor running this term. Please be sure to bring proper running sneakers and a water bottle. Meet in room 121. [This class runs from 3:30 - 4:20](#)

Beginner Magic: Level 1 - Grades 3 - 5, Tuesdays with Mr. Rockis, Library (class size limit 12): Participants in this class will learn how to do simple table magic tricks using playing cards, coins and other "household items". This class will help children with following multi-step directions, using deductive reasoning, and enhancing their receptive, expressive and pragmatic language skills. *This class is limited to 12 students, since the magic being taught requires close up participation and hands on instruction.

Creative Crafts - Grades 1 - 2, Tuesdays and Grades 3 - 5, Wednesdays with Mrs. Mora, Room 121 (class size limit 24): This class is filled with innovative craft-making experiences that are sure to keep big minds engaged and fulfilled! The course will allow students to use their own creative flair to produce one-of-a-kind, personalized works of art, while celebrating the many holidays and events that the Fall season has to offer. \$15 supplies fee.

Kindness Club - Grades 4 - 6, Wednesdays with Mrs. Levine, Room 229 (class size limit 12): Our club focus is to learn small ways to pay it forward. Projects may include coupon cutting to benefit a military family, collecting and wrapping hotel toiletries for families in need, collecting gently used books for Book Fairies and taking charge of the school plastic recycle program. We often find ways to promote random acts of kindness. We have a baking date at the Ronald McDonald House in New Hyde Park in October, details will be provided at our first meeting (limit 11 students). Together, we will make a difference in the lives of others.

Study Skills - Grades K - 6, Tuesdays and/or Thursdays with Mrs. Blank & Mr. Putnam, Room 209 (class size limit 20): Students will learn organizational strategies while completing daily and long term classroom/homework assignments. Students will be guided as they prepare and study for upcoming assessments. ***Please specify your day. Each day has a \$140 per term charge. This class runs from 3:30 - 4:20***
