

It is always exciting to welcome our new and returning families to a new school year at Munsey Park and this year is no exception. Welcome back for another great year!

Our annual "Ice Cream Social" for new children and their buddies was a great success, allowing them to meet before school began. New parents also enjoyed an informational evening on September 10, when sixth graders, reading and math teachers,

our school psychologist, our assistant principal, Mr. Leone and I, provided an overview of the Munsey Park experience. Open House was also a success as parents and teachers began an important partnership.

We welcome the many new teachers and coordinators who joined our Munsey Park family. And as always, we are pleased to continue working with Ellen Duran, SCA President, her Vice President, Debbie Papadopoulos, as well as grade level and event chairs.
