7th and 8th grade: Attended Rachel's Challenge assembly November 18, 2010. The assembly was sponsored by the SCA and discussed with the students ahead of time by the guidance counselors in their health and foreign language classes. A follow up with all of the students was held in their 9th period classes. If parents had any concerns about their child and the impact of the assembly, they should contact their child's guidance counselor.

9th Grade: Counselors are meeting individually with all students. After Thanksgiving, November 29 and 30, counselors will be meeting with all 9th graders in small groups to discuss and review the 9th grade orientation guide. 10th Grade: Last week the counselors held a two-day career workshop with all 10th graders and packets would be mailed home.

12th Grade: 80% of the senior class has submitted college applications to the counseling center.
