Mrs. Mulholland gave a report on Shelter Rock. She thanked the chairs of Health and Fitness Week, Guess Whose Coming To Read, and the Book Fair. She also reported on the Box Top Collection with grade 6 in the lead. Mrs. Molholland also announced that Maturation Night for 5th graders and their parents is on 3/13 and 6th graders on 3/11. Additionally, she stated that chair of the SCA Fair, Linda Gurino, is looking for volunteers to chair some things, such as the Dunk Booth.
