#### **Guidance Update - Marcie Fogel, High School Guidance Counselor**

- **Seniors** over 72% have applied for Early Action / Early Decision
- **Juniors** 11<sup>th</sup> Grade Parent Night was well attended. An overview of the post- secondary planning process was presented. Counselors will begin meeting with students in small groups. 325 Students took the PSATs in October. Results will be in by mid-December.
- **10<sup>th</sup> Grade** two day career workshop begins today. First day matching careers to student interests (career interest inventory, etc.). Day 2 pick a career and do research (how to prepare, etc.)
- **9**<sup>th</sup> **Grade** Counselors will begin meeting individually with students, and then in groups. Students will receive the Orientation Guide companion piece given to parents in September.
- December 2<sup>nd</sup> Financial Aid Night presented by Dr. Jackie Nealon from NYIT
- **December 4<sup>th</sup> -** Standardized Testing 101 presented by Mrs. Grappone.
- **Beginning of January** Returning Graduate Panel. One for parents, one for students.
- **Middle School** fourth and final push-in meetings for 7<sup>th</sup> grade students on the Essential Habits for Successful Students. Counselors also working on new website for MS.

- Overview of MS /HS Music, Arts and Drama Programs
- Comprehensive Music, Arts, Theater Program continuous from K 12
- 100% participation at Elementary Level thru music and choral programs
- The Orff Method utilizes student site-performance-based approach to teaching music
- HS /MS Programs are performance based and highly specialized
- Vocal music program is dense, centralized and offers students the opportunity to explore many types of repertoires in MS and HS
- Men's Chorus 70; Women's from 35 to 43
- Symphonic Choirs 0 -52, Concert Choir 68
- Orchestra Program 70 in 2005 to 104
- Band Program stable at 110 to 120
- Theater program stable (down .5 FTE)
- Visual Arts Program 502 to 579; AP art enrollment robust. MS art from 92 to 217 (no new staff)
- Staffing can be a challenge (finding teachers of excellence)
- Charlie Cardillo Arts and Music are a significant component of the Dec. 3 Bond Vote reflecting the District's commitment to the Arts Programs
