



Dear Manhasset Families,

As we begin the third month of the school year, we are grateful that we have remained open during this time. This remains a collective community effort and one that will continue to require our vigilance.

While we have not received any information from State or local officials that would suggest otherwise, we also recognize that despite our best efforts the possibility does exist that we may be required to implement our remote instruction plan at some point during the school year.

In order to ensure that we are prepared for the possibility of our District being required to go to full remote instruction, we are planning a District wide “practice drill” Remote Instruction Day on Wednesday, November 25, 2020. As such, all K-12 students attending Munsey Park, Shelter Rock or the Secondary School will participate in their regular school day from home via zoom.

Once again, the purpose of this day is to practice the implementation of our remote instruction plan, and to identify and troubleshoot technical or learning challenges that may be encountered. In the coming days you will receive additional information from your child’s school principal.
