To authorize using \$3,185,000 from existing monies in District's 2018 & 2010 Capital Reserves & General Fund Unassigned Fund Balance to fund five projects:

- Shelter Rock K playground; Softball infield turf replacement and creation of multi-use field for Middle School & community use; Secondary School Northwest Field turf replacement; Completion of Secondary School asphalt, water main and sidewalk project; Secondary School ceiling and lighting replacement
- No additional tax impact for residents as funding would come from existing monies
