Class Descriptions:

Act Out: If your child enjoys being dramatic this class is for them! Students will act out popular stories, role play and play theater games. Develop confidence, creativity and acting skills while having fun! The skits and activities will differ from the fall sessions so previous students are welcome to take the class again.

Cardio Jam: This dance exercise program will be 50 minutes of continuous forms of movement. Students will enjoy a variety of music and moves to keep them happy and healthy.

Cartooning and Animation: If you love telling stories through pictures this class is for you. Learn the basics of comic art, create your own characters, develop a story board and translate ideas into paper and pencil using simple drawing skills. Color and technique will also be explored. Imagination a must!

Chess Club: Students of all levels will have the opportunity to play friendly games of chess in a low-stress environment while sharpening their critical thinking, foresight and creativity.

Code Tots: Students will move at their own pace through scaffolded lessons to learn programming concepts in a fun, engaging way & then apply them creatively on multiple computer code applications.

Creative Writing: Get excited about writing! This class will focus on the art of creative writing. We will tap into our imaginations and use them to write creatively. Students will choose topics that are of interest to the members of our group. Each week, different genres and themes of writing will be introduced. Final pieces will be "published." Topics will be different than the fall session so previous students are welcome to take the class again for a different experience. "Getting to know the Masters" Art Club: Explore famous artists and learn to identify their style of art. Students will create drawings and paintings using inspiration from the artists.

**Intensive Code Kidz: Please note this class will run for 5 weeks – 2 days per week (Tues. PM & Thurs. AM) for a total of 10 sessions: Jan. 29, 31 Feb. 5, 7, 12, 14, 26, 28 Mar. 5, 7. Students will learn code in a fun and creative environment with the added consistency of twice a week meeting dates. Students will build a network of friends to work with collaboratively on code projects and challenges. This class progresses at individual levels, fall students welcome. Intro to French: Learn the basics of a beautiful language! The focus will be on basic conversation, color, numbers, shapes,

Kindness Club: In Kindness club, we will promote positivity and kindness for our Shelter Rock family, our Manhasset community and beyond. Projects may include coupon cutting to benefit a military family, collecting and wrapping hotel toiletries for families in need, collecting gently used books for Book Fairies and taking charge of the school plastic recycle program. As students, join us as we will empower the community to be a positive change for good!

Kitchen Science: Students will experiment with common household materials to produce both physical and chemical reactions.

Learning Spanish Through Literature: Students will explore a variety of literature in Spanish while learning to read and speak in Spanish. The children will learn to read *Oso Pardo, Oso Pardo, Que´Ves Ahi´?* in Spanish and have a good understanding of the story. Please note: non-readers welcome!

Learning Through Board Games: Learning through games is so much fun! The students will work cooperatively playing board games that focus on reading skills such as making inferences, main idea, cause & effect, and homonyms. Students will be grouped according to level to ensure a stimulating experience. Each week will focus on different topics to keep it fun & exciting.

Learning to Love Reading and Writing through Poetry: Students will learn strong reading and writing practices through poetry to ensure they will become lifelong learners who can effectively communicate.

Music Composition: Each student will learn the different components of writing a melody, learn about key signatures, time signatures, harmonic progressions, chords and much, much more! Our goal is to create a class composition by the end of the course. Come compose with us!

Obstacle Course Challenges: Each week students will participate in different obstacle courses including jumping, crawling, running, hoops, scooters and ball skills...to name just a few! Children must wear sneakers!

Picture Book Art: Enjoy picture books by famous illustrators, old and new, and create hands-on art projects in the artists' styles.

Rock Runners: Develop basic athletic skills while building a foundation of good running form. The program will address athletic skills such as body awareness and agility, as well as warm-up, cool-down, and stretching routines. We will promote pride in accomplishments and life-long positive habits! **Note:** participants should dress warm as we will go outside weather permitting (in accordance with recess rules).

Shelter Rock TV (videography): Are you interested in learning to film and edit movies? Shelter Rock will serve as an intro to WeVideo/ChromeOS media. Students will leave this club having written, filmed, directed and edited a WeVideo project. **Singing Lessons:** Does your child love to sing? Well this is a wonderful opportunity to work on their vocal skills to perform as a soloist. Each week we will work on breathing, posture, diction, expression and much, much more. Students will learn vocal warm-ups and songs which will improve their vocal sight reading skills.

Sports and Games: Students will participate in various sports in the gym. At each class a different game will be introduced. Students must wear sneakers to participate.

Winter Crafts: Warm up this winter season with some adorable winter crafts. We will be making bird feeders out of pine cones and birdseed, snowmen out of shave cream and glue that pop right off of the paper and many more fun activities to brighten up the winter months.
