FALL 2018 SCA EXTENDED EXTRAS

<u>Class Fee</u>: Each class is **\$140** for the <u>8-week session</u> or **\$155**, if an extra fee applies. Note that Code Kidz is 8 sessions that take place in four weeks. Extra fee for supplies applies to: Jewelry Making, Kitchen Science and Fall Crafts (\$15 fee). Checks are made payable to "Manhasset SCA". Please make individual checks for each child participating. There are no make-ups/refunds after October 22.

- <u>Class Enrollment & Offering</u>: Classes begin the week of October 22. All classes are taught by NY State certified teachers.
 - \circ In case of inclement weather, be mindful of district notifications/cancellations.
 - Students may enroll in more than one class.
 - Enrollment is limited. Classes are filled on a first come first serve basis. You will be notified of your class selection via email. We reserve the right to cancel classes due to lack of enrollment.
- <u>Transportation:</u>
 - There is no early bus for the morning classes. A late bus is offered on Tuesdays and Thursdays, which departs from Shelter Rock School at 4 pm <u>only for Grades 3 and up</u>. Only children of parents who are fully committed to their children riding the late bus on Tuesdays, Thursdays, or both days will be permitted to board the late bus. If considering the late bus -- Please examine your transportation needs and decide <u>definitively</u> if you will routinely pick up your child or have him/her ride the 4:00 PM bus.

Class Descriptions:

Act Out: If your child enjoys being dramatic this class is for them! Students will act out popular stories, role play and play theater games. Develop confidence, creativity and acting skills while having fun!

Cardio Jam: This dance exercise program will be 50 minutes of continuous forms of movement. Students will enjoy a variety of music and moves to keep them happy and healthy.

Chess Club: Students of all levels will have the opportunity to play friendly games of chess in a low-stress environment while sharpening their critical thinking, foresight and creativity.

Creative Writing: This class will focus on the art of creative writing. Students will choose topics that are of interest to the members of our group. Final pieces will be "published."

****Intensive Code Kidz:** Please note <u>this class will only run for 4 weeks – 2 days per week (Tuesday</u> <u>AFTERNOON and Thursday MORNING) for a total of 8 sessions</u>. Students will learn code in a fun and creative environment with the added consistency of twice a week meeting dates. Students will build a network of friends to work with collaboratively on code projects and challenges.

"Getting to know the Masters" Art Club: Explore famous artists and learn to identify their style of art. Students will create drawings and paintings using inspiration from the artists.

Jewelry Making: Students will make "wearable" jewelry. Students will use beads and string along with decorative pieces like tassels to make fun jewelry they will love to wear. Create necklaces & bracelets just like you find in your favorite stores! Come join the fun and "bead" with us!

Kitchen Science: Students will experiment with common household materials to produce both physical and chemical reactions.

Learning Spanish Through Literature: Students will explore a variety of literature in Spanish while learning to read and speak in Spanish. The children will learn to read <u>Oso Pardo, Oso Pardo, Que' Ves Ahi'?</u> in Spanish and have a good understanding of the story.

Learning Through Board Games: Work cooperatively playing games that focus on reading & math skills including making inferences, main idea, cause & effect, homonyms, addition/subtraction, multiplication/division. Students will be grouped according to level to ensure a stimulating experience. Each week will focus on different topics to keep it fun & exciting.

Learning to Love Reading and Writing through Poetry: Students will learn strong reading and writing practices through poetry to ensure they will become lifelong learners who can effectively communicate. Music Composition: Each student will learn the different components of writing a melody, learn about key signatures, time signatures, harmonic progressions, chords and much, much more! Our goal is to create a class composition by the end of the course. Come compose with us!

Obstacle Course Challenges: Each week students will participate in different obstacle courses including jumping, crawling, running, hoops, scooters and ball skills...to name just a few! Children must wear sneakers! **Reading is Magic!** Read and discuss books from Kate Egan's "Magic Shop" series and learn a new magic trick every week!

Reader's Theater: Combine children's folktales with theater, using age-appropriate short scripts. Just bring your enthusiasm -- there are no sets, costumes, props, or need to memorize lines!

Singing Lessons: Does your child love to sing? Well this is a wonderful opportunity to work on their vocal skills to perform as a soloist. Each week we will work on breathing, posture, diction, expression and much, much more. Students will learn vocal warm-ups and songs which will improve their vocal sight reading skills.

Sports and Games: Students will participate in various sports in the gym. At each class a different game will be introduced. Students must wear sneakers to participate.

Fall Crafts: Students will make fun crafts out of different materials with a fall theme. We will use fall materials when available (i.e. pine cones).
