Guidance Update- Kim Cosenza, HS Guidance Department

- 78% of seniors applications are in, both regular and early action/early decision
- Department was set back 2 weeks because of storm but no students were penalized
- All documents were submitted on time; many school granted extensions
- 10th grade meetings to discuss careers will be rescheduled
- 7th grade class push-in's will be rescheduled as well
- Nov. 27th and Nov. 28th the 9th grade will be meeting in small groups to discuss graduation requirements
- Jan. 4th there will be a <u>Returning Graduate Panel</u>; 5-6 2012 Manhasset graduates will speak about the college application process, getting response letters from colleges, their first semester at college, etc.; parents invited 10:00-11:15 students 11:25-12:50
- PSAT results will be mailed out mid-December, you will receive results and test booklet to help students prepare for SAT
- Nov. 27 7:30pm Financial Aid Night in Black Box
- Nov 29 7:30pm Standardized Testing Presentation in Auditorium
- All students taking ACT and SAT need to have a photo ID uploaded to website for security purposes before taking test

School Board Report

- School District needs 180 instructional days in order to receive state aid
- We missed 8 days of school due to Hurricane Sandy and the Nor'easter
- Board is discussing many options and is looking for community feedback at this time
- Please email the School Board by 11/29, their decision will be announced that evening at the board meeting
- Some options they are considering:
 - 1. Having school on Monday 3/25 during March break
 - 2. Having school on Monday, 4/1 during March break
 - 3. Eliminating midterm week at High School/Middle School, making it a regular, instructional week
 - 4. Eliminating February break, but concerned about attendance, need 80% attendance district wide to count as an instructional day

Principals' Report- Dean Schlanger

- 1st quarter is extended to Nov. 16
- 1st quarter grades will be posted to the Parent Portal and mailed on 11/26 at 4:00pm
- The 2nd quarter will be one week shorter, its dates will not change
- 2nd quarter progress reports will be mailed on 12/14 and the quarter will end on Jan. 25
- There will be no conferences on December 5th; please reach out to teachers now if you have questions, if there is an issue or a problem
- Teachers have been instructed to put additional comments on the report card and upcoming progress report if necessary
- Midterm Week is still in discussion; teachers will not be able to give a midterm during class time just a regular unit exam at the end of the quarter. Teachers will adjust grading to reflect loss of a midterm
- Have asked for minimum interruption to classroom instruction for example less field trips
- AP Exams:
 - 1. All material will be covered in time for the exam
 - 2. College board considering extending date of AP exams
- Music rotations have been adjusted for certain classes based on time lost due to storm
- Seniors will send mid year grades to colleges they have applied to, no midterms will be posted on their transcripts
- Nov. 19 National Honor Society Induction at 7:30pm at Munsey Park Auditorium
- All other Honor Society Inductions that were cancelled due to storm have been postponed to December and January

MEA Representative Update on APPR- Ed Vasta

- All teachers were happy to volunteer after Hurricane Sandy to staff the labs and libraries for the extended hours
- Our district is following Kim Marshall's plan for teacher and administration evaluation; it is comprised of a rubric with 6 domains and it closely resembled the existing observation and evaulation process that was already established in the district.
- The one aspect that the teachers object to with the new process is the pre-assessment and post- assessment that they must now administer to the students. The teachers feel the extra testing is unnecessary and directly affects the children.
- The district will be conducting 10 unannounced mini lesson observations of each teacher; untenured teachers will have a combination of announced and unannounced.
- At the end of the school year the teachers and administration will meet to evaluate the process to discuss if felt if was successful and how can improve process going forward.
