2. Superintendent's Report

- **A. Dr. Passi, Acting Superintendent** Welcome, today is the ninth day of school. We are looking forward to the pep rally this afternoon and homecoming tomorrow. The goal is to return to pre-pandemic normal by connecting the students and the community. All extracurricular and co-curricular activities are back. In the classroom there is social distancing of 3fl. In the cafeteria there is 6 ft. social distancing. Dean Schlanger is maximizing outdoor spaces.
- **B.** Summer Construction The construction has been substantially completed on time. Many thanks to the Deputy Superintendent for overseeing the work on the creation of the Wellness and Learning Center, the Middle School Commons, Broadcast Journalism Room, Technology Space, Secondary School traffic redesign and new asphalt and the water main project. The walkway redesign is much safer for pedestrians. On the first day of school, there were traffic delays due to rain. By Friday, traffic flowed smoothly and all was clear by 8:05am.
- **COVID !9 mitigation -** Two primary objectives The first is to return the district to pre-pandemic normal with in person learning. Secondly, Manhasset is implementing layered mitigation efforts as per the CDC guidelines. In the classrooms, there is social distancing of 3ft. In the cafeteria, there is social distancing of 6ft. Dean Schlanger is maximizing outdoor spaces. Students are able to use lockers. All athletics and extracurricular activities are back.

- **D.** Computer Network Disruption on September 14, 2021. There is an ongoing investigation about the problem. The district is working methodically and diligently for answers and to restore service. IT is on it. Instruction is still happening. Dr. Passi has visited classrooms in all three schools. The teachers have adapted to traditional methods of teaching as done in the past when we were students. Hot spots are working for all of the departments so that teachers have access during prep periods. On Monday, Sept. 20, 2021, Google drive and copier machines will be up and running.
- E. Christine Monterosso, Vice President of the school board, noted that the students are all safe. The teachers and administrators have Emergency APPS on their phones for fire alarms, safety evacuations and other safety precautions. Phone service has been restored.

3. Principal's Report - Dean Schlanger, Principal of the secondary school

- Welcomed everyone back and assured everyone that the building is safe.
- There was an evacuation drill on Wednesday and everything went smoothly.
- Spirit week has been festive. Participation has been great.
- Senior portraits are just about complete.
- The traffic pattern is being monitored and tweaked. Dean Schlanger, Marc Oppenheimer and security are directing traffic every morning. The walkways are and bike paths are being reviewed as well. The kids have been very cooperative.
- Thank you for the Social Emotional Learning Center. After lunch, students are able to use the Center or go outside.
- The Homecoming parade is tomorrow. This year instead of floats, students and parents are decorating cars to drive in the parade.
- The Class of 1966 will be touring the building and have breakfast.

4. Secondary School Assistant Principal Presentation - Marc Oppenheimer

- Originally from Ohio, the Buckeye state where he worked as a band leader for 17 years.
- Currently in his seventh year as an administrator, he is replacing Kelly Ramsey as the new assistant principal.
- He is focused on working with Mr. Vercessi on managing attendence and working with Joy Anne D'Anca in guidance.
- Proud father of three daughters, he is a sports and health fanatic that plays the classical and jazz trumpet.

5. Joy Anne D'Anca, Director of Guidance/Counseling Grades 7-12

- As Dr. Passi discussed the students are resilent and adapting well. The computer network disruption has been eased by the hot spots.
