Membership Dues collection currently totals close to \$21,000 which is short of the budgeted \$35,000 for the year.
 Efforts should be made to increase membership with email reminders sent via room representatives and/or the school messaging system. The upcoming SCA luncheon could generate membership donation opportunities as well as the upcoming elementary school holiday concerts.

PROGRAMS

- Project Share received a donation from Munsey Park Women's Club totaling \$10,000.
- Spiritwear sales have been successful for both Munsey Park and Shelter Rock schools. Munsey Park netted a total of \$10,870 and Shelter Rock netted a total of \$13,500. Both sets of Spiritwear committees have plans to continue to sell merchandise at upcoming events throughout the year.
- Planet Manhasset has netted \$678 with merchandise sales since the start of the year.
- Shelter Rock and Munsey Park are planning for the upcoming Book Week festivities with the purchases and/or rentals of costumes.
- Additionally, the elementary schools as well as Middle school are preparing for the upcoming Halloween parties at each school with deposits and payments out to DJs and entertainment companies.
- The Family Theatre production of The Cat in the Hat is set to be held March 18, 2023 a deposit of \$500 has been made to Plaza Theatrical Productions.
- The College Essay Workshop has received a total of \$3,610 which is the deposit of tuition checks from the previous school year (2021-22) and is not reflective of any change to the future budget; it is simply a timing difference in deposit collection.
