Class Descriptions:

Beadie Buddies: The children will be working with string and beads to create different animals and items. They can become keychains to hang on your backpack or even in your room! Students will be able to socialize and interact using hands on skills to be imaginative.

Cartooning: If you love telling stories through pictures, this class is for you! Learn the basics of comic art, create your own characters, develop a story board and translate ideas into paper and pencil by using simple drawing skills. Color and technique will also be explored. Imagination is a must!

Creative Board Games: Children will create their own board game! Students will develop a game concept, illustrate it and carefully outline game rules. For our final class, students will play the games they created! Objectives are to encourage creativity, problem solving, and a plan to execute an idea from start to finish.

Creative Writing: Get excited about writing! This class will focus on the art of creative writing. We will tap into our imaginations and use them to write creatively. Students will choose topics that are of interest to the members of our group. Each week, different genres and themes of writing will be introduced. Final pieces will be “published.” Topics will be different than the Fall session. Previous students are welcome to take the class again for a different experience.

Fall Arts & Crafts: Warm up this fall season with some adorable fall craft. This program would include a fun way to have students dive into hands on activities, showing off their creative sides. We will do an array of different projects and students will be able to interact while using creativity through projects.

Hip Hop, Rhythm and Dance: Can you hear the beat? In this class, children will learn basic fundamentals that make up hip hop dance through technical teachings, stretches for flexibility, creative movements and fun choreography.

Jewelry Making: Do you have a “thing for bling”? Create your own jewelry fashion. Students will use beads, charms, tassels and other materials to make fun wearable jewelry. Come join the fun and “bead” with us.

Kindness Club: Our club focus is to learn small ways to pay it forward. Projects include: Coups for Troops: cut coupons to send to military families overseas, Project Linus Blankets: make no-sew blankets bring comfort to those that experience illnesses or loss, collect and wrap hotel toiletries for families in need. Book Fairies: collect and donate gently used books and make projects for those service men and women in our Manhasset Fire House. In our Shelter Rock community, we will kick start the school recycling program and spread kindness through Chalk-Outs and Kindness boards. Together, we will make a difference in the lives of others.

Kitchen Science: Students will experiment with common household material to produce both physical and chemical reactions.

Learn to play the Ukulele: This is a wonderful opportunity for students to learn a new instrument, the ukulele. The ukulele is a great instrument for children to learn as it is small portable and has easy cord shapes. **Each child must provide their own ukulele. Ukulele’s range from \$20-\$50 and can be purchased on Amazon.** Students will learn to hold, tune and play the ukulele. Each child will be able to play chord progressions to pop and folk songs.

Lego Madness: Come create with Legos! We will build independently and in teams collaborating to solve a specific task with their Legos based on various themes. Each task has different constraints like time and number of pieces. Students will be encouraged to tap into their creativity, work in team, problem solve and collaborate with peers.

Mindfulness and Meditation for the Mini Minds: This class will have students thinking of ways to be kind. We will explore, journal and share ways of solving problems in a positive way. Music, quotes and meditation will engage thoughtful thinking and having students slow down as they begin their day.

Morning Sports: In this program students will explore new activities while building and reinforcing on prior psychomotor, emotional and social skills. They will participate in small and large group activities as well as individual challenges.

Movement K-3: Students will use rhythm and dance moves while moving and grooving to kid friendly music! Through dance, students will learn teamwork, focus, and kinesthetic learning.

Picture Book Art: Enjoy the picture books by famous illustrators and create art projects in the artists' styles.

Singing: Do you love to sing? This class will focus on the skills you need to sing your favorite song like a pro! We will learn some sight reading, breathing techniques, and other strategies singers use to sound their best. Students will develop good vocal habits and emerging music literacy.

Spanish, Beginner / Intermediate: Want to learn Spanish? This will be a fun and engaging class for students to learn how to communicate in Spanish. NO previous knowledge necessary! Students will learn the basics of how to communicate in Spanish while having fun. They will learn about different Spanish speaking cultures about the world too!

Spanish, Advanced : Quieres mejorar tu español? This class will be an exciting way for students to build and enhance their Spanish skills. Students will learn and improve their proficiency in reading, writing, listening and speaking through authentic lessons and techniques.

*Spanish courses are subject to change in level depending upon enrollment. Please reach out if a time works but the level is not what you would prefer *

String Duets & Trios: This class will have students learning and performing in small string groups of duets and trios! Students will have the opportunity to perform in the hallways in December. Students will analyze small group music, utilize active listening and reflection, and will be creative in their interpretation of music.

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- **I AM VOLUNTARILY PARTICIPATING IN THE AFOREMENTIONED ACTIVITY AND I AM PARTICIPATING IN THE ACTIVITY ENTIRELY AT MY OWN RISK. I agree that this obligation to indemnify and hold harmless the SCA shall survive after the end of the Activity.

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- **I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT THIS ACTIVITY MAY INVOLVE A TEST OF A PERSON'S PHYSICAL AND MENTAL LIMITS AND MAY CARRY WITH IT THE POTENTIAL FOR DEATH, SERIOUS INJURY, AND**

PROPERTY LOSS. The risks may include, but are not limited to, those caused by terrain, facilities, temperature, weather, lack of hydration, condition of participants, equipment, vehicular traffic and actions of others, including but not limited to, participants, volunteers, spectators, coaches, event officials and event monitors, and/or producers of the event.

I EXPRESSLY AGREE TO RELEASE AND DISCHARGE THE SCA AND ALL OF ITS AFFILIATES, MANAGERS, MEMBERS, AGENTS, ATTORNEYS, STAFF, VOLUNTEERS, HEIRS, REPRESENTATIVES, PREDECESSORS, SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, FROM ANY AND ALL CLAIMS OR CAUSES OF ACTION AND I AGREE TO VOLUNTARILY GIVE UP OR WAIVE ANY RIGHT THAT I OTHERWISE HAVE TO BRING A LEGAL ACTION AGAINST THE SCA FOR PERSONAL INJURY OR PROPERTY DAMAGE.**
- To the extent that statute or case law does not prohibit releases for negligence, this release is also for negligence on the part of the SCA, its agents, and employees.
- In the event that I should require medical care or treatment, I agree to be financially responsible for any costs incurred as a result of such treatment. I am aware and understand that I should carry my own health insurance.
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- **Allergies: The SCA is not responsible for any reactions, illness, injury, or other loss suffered or caused for known or unknown allergies. By signing below, you acknowledge that you have read and understand this statement and exclude the SCA from any liability.**
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- In the event that any damage to equipment or facilities occurs as a result of my or my family's willful actions, neglect or recklessness, I acknowledge and agree to be held liable for any and all costs associated with any actions of neglect or recklessness.
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- This Agreement was entered into at arm's-length, without duress or coercion, and is to be interpreted as an agreement between two parties of equal bargaining strength. Both the Participant and the SCA agree that this Agreement is clear and unambiguous as to its terms, and that no other evidence will be used or admitted to alter or explain the terms of this Agreement, but that it will be interpreted based on the language in accordance with the purposes for which it is entered into.
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- In the event that any provision contained within this Waiver and Release of Liability shall be deemed to be severable or invalid, or if any term, condition, phrase or portion of this agreement shall be determined to be unlawful or otherwise unenforceable, the remainder of this agreement shall remain in full force and effect, so long as the clause severed does not affect the intent of the parties. If a court should find that any provision of this agreement to be invalid or unenforceable, but that by limiting said provision it would become valid and enforceable, then said provision shall be deemed to be written, construed and enforced as so limited.

I am voluntarily participating in the Activity and acknowledge that by doing so I am increasing my risk of exposure to the Coronavirus/COVID-19.
